



Our Lancasterian Primary School vision says that 'we will make a fairer society' and that, in order to do this, 'we will make the best school'.



Ignacio is a dependable value to have in our community. When he makes a promise you know he will keep it! He treasures every one — locking it away in his chest for safe keeping.





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

He uses his shiny watch to always be on time and helps others by slapping the floor excitedly with his tail when it's time to line up.


