
This is a help guide to enable your child to use some of the online resources we have access to as a school.

Your child has access to Purplemash, J2e, Busy things and Times Tables Rockstars using their London Grid for learning (LGFL) login.


Purplemash

You will then be taken to the following page...




Click here to login

Type in your child's username and password.




When your child logs in they will be faced with the following page. You can search by **subject** or type something specific in the **search box**.





To log into J2e go to www.j2e.com


Click on the one that says London Grid for Learning




Next click on the one that says **Normal USO login**








Next type in your child's LGFL login....






Google – Times tables Rockstars and click on login. Select **School Pupils**




Type the school's post code: **n17 8nn**






Type in your username and password
