We have missed you while in lockdown!

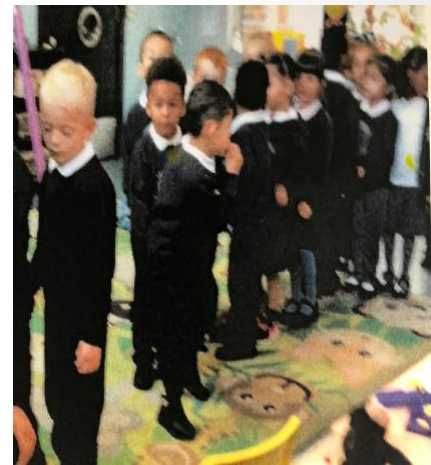
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Here are some pictures from

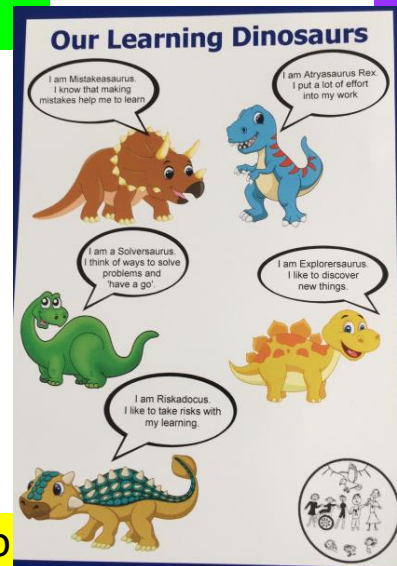


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While you were in Williams class we.....
