Contact Tracing Over The Christmas Holiday

In order to assist with contact tracing over the Christmas break and following Department for Education guidelines:

• If your child tests positive for Coronavirus, having developed <u>symptoms within 48 hours of last being in school</u>, please call Mr Murphy on the school mobile 07385709492 any day between 11am – 1pm to let him know. He will then inform other class members and staff via Parenthub that they need to isolate for 14 days.

• However, if your child tests positive for Coronavirus having developed <u>symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school</u>, the school should not be contacted and you should follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

It is anticipated that no-one would need to contact the school beyond Christmas Eve following these guidelines and the phone will be switched off from 1pm on Thursday 24th December.


